






We aim to continue the centuries old tradition of learning from classical texts for our future imams and provide an opportunity to those individuals who may not be able to study abroad at Islamic institutions.



Al-Isnad Website

The website is also a bank that holds all previous courses. Each course will contain videos of the lessons, audio files for podcast listening as well as the course notes.



Live online Q&A

After each course, there is an online Q&A that takes place. Students are asked to send in their questions, and the shaykh will answer them.



Student Breakfast

On the second day of each course, Al-Isnad provides a continental breakfast for attendees. This also gives the students an opportunity to sit with the shaykh and speak to him informally and seek advice.



Al-Isnad Kids

This is an initiative to encourage young people to seek knowledge and study their religion. Each course, a question sheet is prepared for young people that focuses on the first morning of the class.

Once completed, students hand it in for a small gift.



Telegram Group

Al-Isnad has a Telegram group with more than 300 students currently. The group is a forum for discussion, revision and questions. It is student led and focuses on all past courses.
